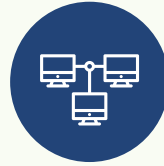

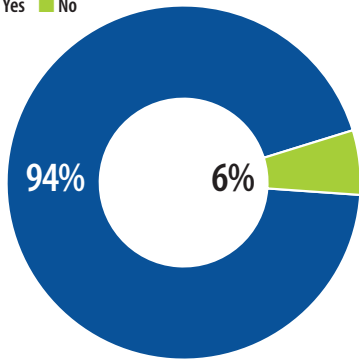

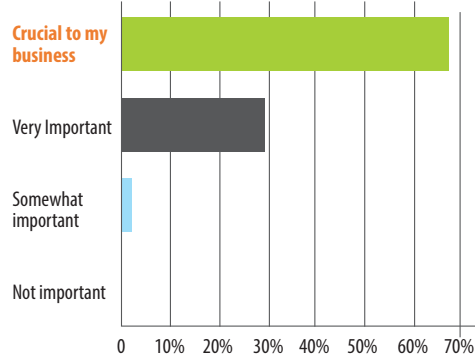
If you are a home-based business, do you utilize your internet service for personal use as well?

■ Yes ■ No



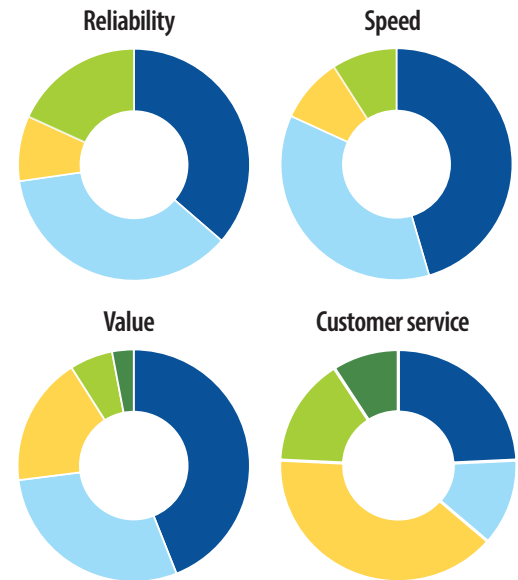
How important is access to the internet for your business?
