

IMPORTANT Applicants must complete the following:

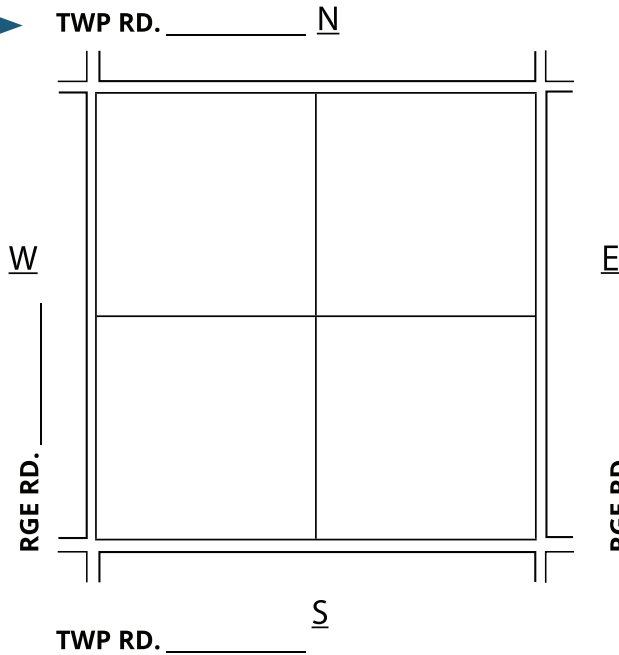
ON THE PLAN TO THE RIGHT:

- Indicate the approximate location of the house and approach/entrance (see example below).
- Indicate how many metres of dust suppression you require on each side of the approach.

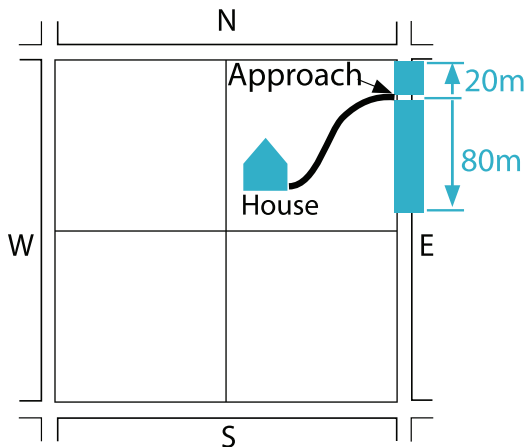
AT YOUR PROPERTY:

- County crews will put stakes up at your property to identify where the product will be placed.
- **DO NOT MOVE THESE STAKES.** Contact the County office (780-939-8252) to request changes.
- Dust Suppression is typically applied starting in late spring (weather permitting).

Dust suppression will be applied as per placement of stakes and the submitted plan. Sturgeon County reserves the right to adjust the segment should a discrepancy exist.

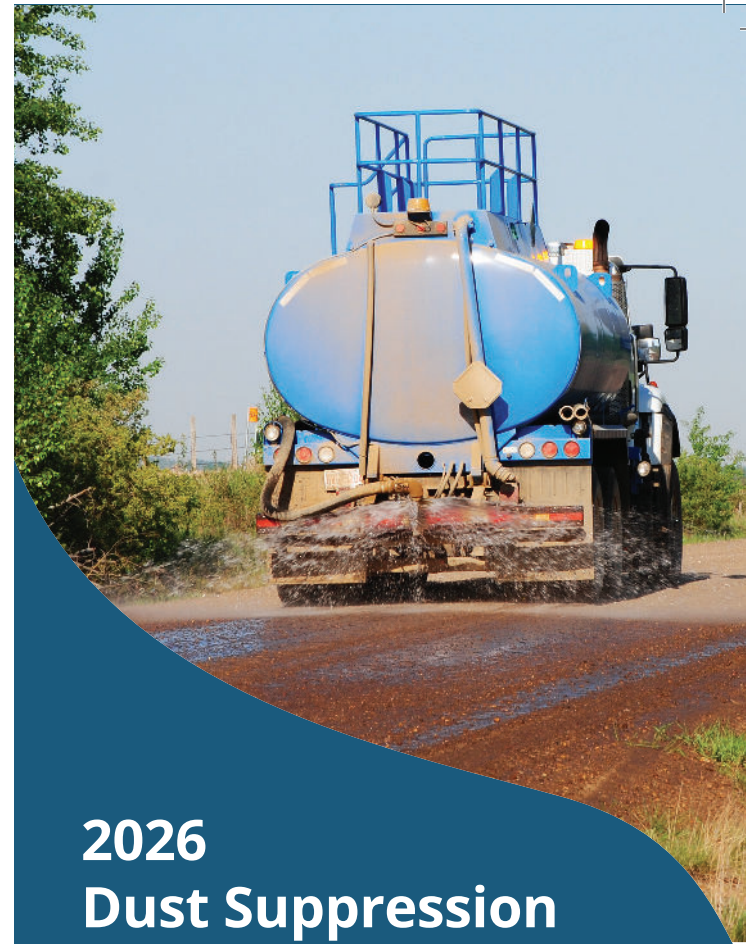

Early bird deadline is April 16

A late fee of \$100 is applied to orders received after that date. **No orders will be accepted after May 17.**

The dust suppression cost is shared between the County and the applicant. Fees vary based on the type and length of dust suppression purchased.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Dust suppression products can reduce dust on gravel roads, but won't eliminate it.
- Sturgeon County subsidizes the first 100m of dust suppression for residents (\$775 this year). Additional length may be purchased by resident if desired.
- Application forms are processed in the order they are received. Your neighbour's stakes may appear earlier than yours.
- Sturgeon County may undertake work on any treated areas to maintain a safe driving surface.
- It is the customer's responsibility to notify the County if dust suppression requires maintenance over the current summer. You can use the portal: transfeedback.sturgeoncounty.ca
