BYLAW 1450/19 AMENDMENT TO BYLAW 1354/15 - FIRE SERVICES BYLAW STURGEON COUNTY, MORINVILLE, ALBERTA

A BYLAW OF STURGEON COUNTY, ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE FIRE SERVICES. BYLAW 1354/15.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000 c.M-26, and any amendments thereto, authorizes Council to establish and amend the Fire Services Bylaw 1354/15;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Sturgeon County, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Bylaw 1354/15 is amended as follows:

> The following text is added to Section 3: 3.1 (q) - ice rescue.

Section 13.2 is deleted and replaced by the following:

- 13.2 For facilities which are regulated under a provincial environmental operating approval or license, reporting is only required if the actual or anticipated release of Dangerous Good(s) is or could reasonably be expected to be in excess of a quantity or concentration specified by the Provincial or Federal regulation or also endangers, or could reasonably be expected to endanger, public safety.
- 2. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon being passed.
