

BYLAW 1450/19
AMENDMENT TO BYLAW 1354/15 – FIRE SERVICES BYLAW
STURGEON COUNTY, MORINVILLE, ALBERTA

A BYLAW OF STURGEON COUNTY, ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE FIRE SERVICES BYLAW 1354/15.

WHEREAS, the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000 c.M-26, and any amendments thereto, authorizes Council to establish and amend the Fire Services Bylaw 1354/15;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Sturgeon County, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Bylaw 1354/15 is amended as follows:

The following text is added to Section 3:

3.1 (q) – ice rescue.

Section 13.2 is deleted and replaced by the following:

13.2 For facilities which are regulated under a provincial environmental operating approval or license, reporting is only required if the actual or anticipated release of Dangerous Good(s) is or could reasonably be expected to be in excess of a quantity or concentration specified by the Provincial or Federal regulation or also endangers, or could reasonably be expected to endanger, public safety.

2. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon being passed.
