2. Adoption of Agenda and Minutes – Cathy Gilbert, Chair

- M. Chuiko moved that the AARTF recommend option 1 (blended diversified agriculture & agritourism use) and option 3 (new land use district – “Agriculture 2”) to Sturgeon County Council subject to review and consensus on the intensity matrix, R. Boissonnault seconded the motion. *Carried.*

6. Refresher Committee Code of Conduct – Jackie Sargent, Sturgeon County

- Presentation given by Jackie Sargent on the committee code of conduct.
 - The Task Force Chair is the spokesperson for the Task Force. Media questions must be directed through the Chair.
 - Members are free to express their opinions as long as they accurately state the Task Force’s decisions and acknowledge that decision-making rests with the Task Force as a whole.
 - Members must not divulge information that was provided in closed session (in private) at a Task Force meeting until the information is made public.
 - Once the Task Force is dissolved, those who served on the Task Force are not restricted from participating in future steps of the process.
 - Any Land Use Bylaw amendment would require a Public Hearing.
 - Former Task Force members would be permitted to participate in this process as a private citizen, ensuring that they do not identify themselves as a representative of the Task Force.
