Dear Property Owners and Residents:

Re: Notice of road construction in Turfside Park

Sturgeon County is planning significant infrastructure improvements in your area this summer. A Sturgeon County contractor will be rehabilitating the subdivision roads in Turfside Park. This project is scheduled to begin on September 9, 2024, weather permitting.

Scope of Work

Road reconstruction will take place around the cul-de-sac, followed by the paving of the reconstructed road. Minor ditch work and a culvert replacement will be done to improve drainage at one location. Additionally, Lasso Trail will be overlaid with asphalt from Range Road 274 to the cul-de-sac. We expect that the project will take three to four weeks to complete. Please be aware that construction schedule may change depending on weather conditions.

What this means to you

There will be Sturgeon County project personnel, contractor crews, and equipment working in the area. There will be temporary one lane closures with detour signs in place. Access to your home will be maintained throughout construction, but delays may occur.
