This summer, a contractor applied micro-surfacing to the roads in your community. As we have shared with you, some parts of the work didn't meet our expectations. Sturgeon County is working with the contractor to remedy these issues, and several deficiency repairs have already been completed.

Any remaining repairs will be completed in the spring when conditions allow. Our contracts have provisions to ensure the contractor is responsible for correcting any deficient work, safeguarding the County's interests throughout the process.

The County also recognizes the concerns raised by a few residents about our oversight on this construction project. We are committed to reviewing our processes to identify any improvements for future projects.
