## RE: Follow up on landscaping project in Waterdale dry pond

Sturgeon County values the opportunity to share an update regarding the final stage of the Waterdale dry pond project: the landscaping. At our last public engagement session on February 20, 2024, we promised to keep you updated as the project neared completion.

The County has selected Stratis Construction to complete the trail and landscaping enhancements around the pond and area. The work will include the construction of a gravel walking trail, benches, picnic tables, and other features around the pond and between Ivan Road community entrances. Landscaping around the pond will include the planting of various trees and shrubs. The concept plan is attached to this letter.

The project is expected to take around six weeks to complete, weather permitting. The work will start in mid-September, and it is our goal to have the project done before October 30, 2024.
