

## E.2b Recommendations and endorsements

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### Feb Meeting:

- Open Houses - ongoing endorsement of Divisional Open Houses with consideration to reduce to two from three; or alternate years.
- Agriculture equipment network navigation – endorsed that entire network remain available to agricultural equipment (no to limited corridors).
- Bridge culverts replacing bridge/guardrail installations – endorsed transition to bridge culverts as they don't require guardrail which can limit large equipment movement.

# Recommendations and endorsements

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## May Meeting:

- Mineral Oil DS – endorsed use of millings with mineral oil product, recommendation to close the time duration between millings and mineral oil placement to minimize washboards.
- Gravel Roads Modernization Initiative – endorsed establishing service levels, and education to bridge the gap between level of service and level of expectation.
- Traffic calming initiative – endorsed
- Farm & Land Approaches – recommend ensuring these are wide enough to accommodate agricultural equipment (on roads where improvements are being undertaken).

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## July Meeting:

- Railway Crossing Rehabilitation Initiative – endorsed.
- Weed control as part of contracts – recommendation to incorporate weed control requirement for high quality seed mix and locally sourced topsoil to finish sites following construction activities.
- Construction projects within subdivision – recommendation not to use highway specification for landscaping.

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## September Meeting:

- When considering which roads to pave, recommendations is that proposed projects near existing County paved roads or provincial highways which offer comparable connectivity should not be prioritized
- Endorsement of the current gravel roads grader operator training, and recommendation for its continuation.
