ELECTION OF CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL AT LARGE

STURGEON COUNTY, MORINVILLE, ALBERTA

A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF STURGEON COUNTY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ELECTION OF THE CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL AT LARGE.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.1, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1994, and amendments thereto provide that a Council may pass a by-law providing for the chief elected official of a municipality to be elected by a vote of the electors of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, Sturgeon County has been petitioned to pass a bylaw to have the chief elected official elected by a vote of the electors;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipality of Sturgeon County in the Province of Alberta duly assembled, and pursuant to the authority conferred upon it by the Municipal Government Act enacts as follows:

1. That the Chief Elected Official of Sturgeon County be elected by a vote of electors of the County at large.
