Semi-Annual Update of Updates for Calahoo Pit – Development Permit No 305305-D-0264

Amrize Canada Inc. (Amrize), formerly Lafarge Canada Inc. (Lafarge) is providing a semi-annual update of operations to landowners within 1.6km of our Calahoo Pit operations.

## **2025 Operations Summary**

Amrize commenced road upgrades to Township Road 544A, along with the intersections with Range Road 272 and Township Road 544, in late April. The work was completed in the summer month, with the county issuing the construction completion certificate in early September. Amrize will continue with dust control and maintenance of these upgraded roads for the duration of our pit operations through conditions in our Road Use Agreement.

Lafarge commenced earthworks operations concurrently with the county road updates, which included the initial installation of the topsoil, subsoil and overburden berms along the north property line, starting on the east side of the project in NE27 and expanding the berms into NW27 this late summer and fall. Amrize and Sureway Construction have been concurrently working onsite since late April developing the site and exposing pit run for processing. Earthworks will be continue through the fall and slow down during the winter months but will continue in some capacity as Amrize prepares the site for 2026 operations. As part of the expansion of the perimeter berms into the NW27 lands, an operational decision was made to remove all of the trees to facilitate for more practical site development in 2026.

Amrize commenced crushing operations on May 31 and will continue throughout through the fall and winter months of 2025 due to the high volumes of material required by our customers and clients. The duration will be dependent upon aggregate demand through the non-construction season and the onset of colder weather. Amrize's crushing operations continue within Mining Phase 1 and 2, as shown below on page 2.

Lastly, Heidelberg Material commenced hauling pit run from Mining Phase 1 on September 5 and hauling will continue through September and October between 7am to 11pm and in accordance with their Road Use Agreement. Amrize is also hauling processed aggregates to our customers and clients, in accordance with hours set in our Road Use Agreement, which usually Monday through Saturday.

## **2025 Correspondence with Residents and Local Community**

Amrize provided Sturgeon County with a detailed document outlining our spring 2025 operations in late March 2025 for insertion into the county portal on gravel pits and for distribution to residents and neighbors. Unfortunately, we did not receive proper instructions for distributing the information from Sturgeon County and the document was also not posted on the county website or at the sand and gravel committee. We have rectified this matter and Amrize and the county will collaboratively ensure that the proper information is being shared with neighbors and residents.



Armize completed an open house in Calahoo on Tuesday September 16<sup>th</sup> from 5pm – 7pm to discuss our operations, which included Amrize personnel along with employees of Sturgeon County.
