Proclamation

Whereas, November is Family Violence Prevention Month in Alberta—a time to raise awareness about the signs of family violence and let people know that help is available; and

Whereas, family violence can affect anyone—regardless of age, ability, background, gender identity, or sexual orientation—and statistics show family violence remains one of the most prevalent, yet underreported crimes in Alberta; and

Whereas, ending family violence requires a collective effort that involves survivors leading with courage, and strong partnerships among police, the justice system, elected leaders, non-profit organizations and community members; and

Whereas, Sturgeon County's Family and Community Services department provides counselling, resources and support to victims of family violence and their loved ones;

Therefore, I, Alanna Hnatiw, Mayor of Sturgeon County, officially proclaim November as Family Violence Prevention Month in Sturgeon County. I ask all residents to take this opportunity to reflect on how we can work together to stop family violence and support survivors in our community.
