

# Cardiff Park Skating Trail

Welcome! Although Sturgeon County maintains the skating surfaces, please thoroughly check the ice before you skate, as this is an unsupervised area.

Skaters use these surfaces at their own risk.

## Guidelines for use:

- **NO PETS ALLOWED**
  - Children under 8 years of age must be accompanied on ice and actively supervised by a responsible person aged 13+.
  - Skates must be worn on the ice.
  - Helmets are strongly recommended for all skaters.
  - Carrying an infant on the ice, regardless of helmet or safety attire, is not permitted.
  - The following items are not permitted on the ice:
    - Sticks, pucks, and rings of any kind, including hockey & ringette sticks
    - Food or beverages
    - Toboggans, sleighs, or wagons
    - Child car seats, baby carriers, or strollers
    - Smoking or controlled substances
  - All skaters must leave the ice during scheduled maintenance.
  - Please be considerate of other skaters who are using the ice surface.
- Sharing is strongly encouraged so that everyone can have fun on the ice.

## Please also note:

- The skating trail is a natural ice surface and injuries can happen due to natural/unnatural hazards such as uneven surfaces, cracks in the ice, holes, rocks, weather/ice conditions, and other skaters.
- The trail may be closed due to poor conditions or weather. The ice is checked daily.
